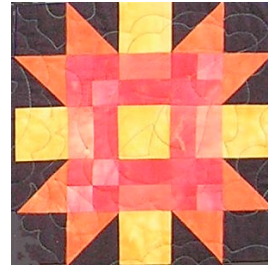

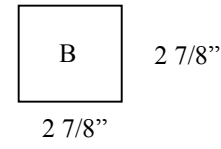
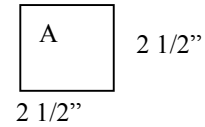
**Block of the Month #10**

**Finished Size: 10"**

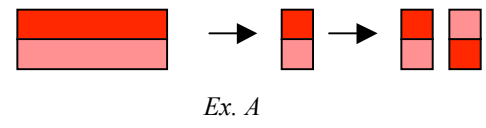


<b>Fabric</b>	<b>Yardage</b>	<b>Cutting</b>
Orange	6 X 6	4 (B)
Coral	3 1/2 X 13	2--1 1/2" strips
Red	3 1/2 X 13	2--1 1/2" strips
Yellow	6 X 8"	5 (A)
Navy	9 X 12"	4 (A) 4 (B)

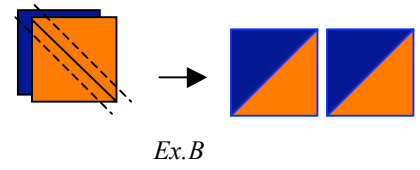


**Sewing Directions**

1. Sew a red 1 1/2" strip to a coral 1 1/2" strip. Repeat. Cross cut one strip set into eight 1 1/2" wide units. Sew together to make four 4-patch blocks as shown in *Ex. A*

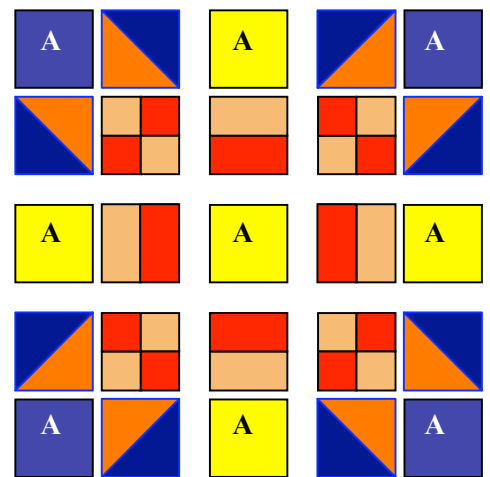


Cross cut the second strip set into four 2 1/2" wide units.



2. Make half square triangles by pairing orange (B) squares with navy (B) squares. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. (*Ex. B*). Cut on the drawn line and press toward the navy fabric. This should result in a total of eight half square triangles.

3. Lay out block pieces according to Block Assembly Diagram. Sew pieces into units, then the units into rows. Sew rows together. Press.
