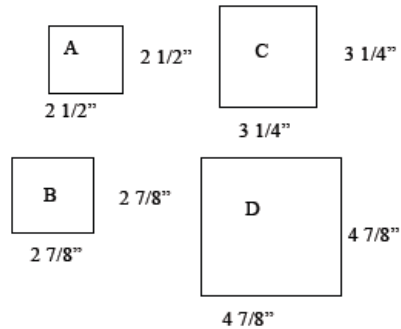

## Block of the Month #9



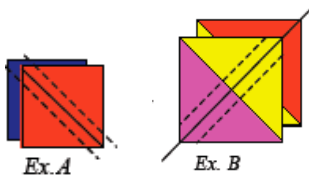
**Celestial Glow**  
**Finished Size: 10"**



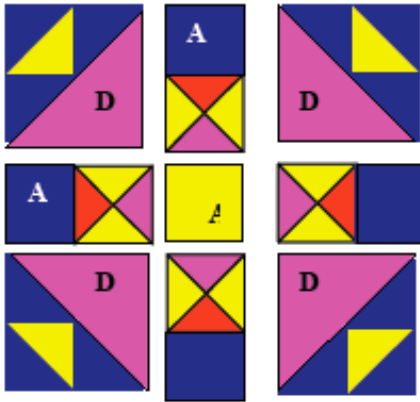
Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
Fuchsia	10 X 10"	1 (C) 2 (D)
Red	8 X 8"	2 (B) 1 (C)
Yellow	8 X 8"	1 (A) 2 (C)
Navy	9 X 12"	6 (B) 6 (A)

### Sewing Directions

1. Make half square triangles by pairing two red (B) squares with 2 navy (B) squares. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from both sides of the drawn line. (Ex. A). Cut on the drawn line and press toward the navy fabric. This should result in a total of four half square triangles.



2. Pair a yellow (C) square with a fuchsia (C) square. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on drawn line and press seams toward fuchsia.
3. Repeat the process described in step two using the yellow and red (C) squares. Press seams toward the red fabric. Place a yellow/fuchsia half square triangle placing right sides together and making sure yellow triangles are opposite each other. Seams should next together. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner so that it is perpendicular to the seam line. Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from both sides of drawn line. (Ex. B) Cut on drawn line. Repeat to yield 4 units.
4. Cut fuchsia (D) squares in half diagonally. Cut remaining navy (B) diagonally to create triangles to complete fuchsia (D) triangle blocks. Lay out block pieces according to Block Assembly Diagram. Sew pieces into units, then the units into rows. Sew rows together. Press. Note that in the Block Assembly Diagram the corner yellow block is actually red fabric.
