Please bring

Basic tools:

1. *Small rotary cutter and sharp blade/or scissors if you prefer
 2. Cutting mat
 3. Iron and board
 4. ballpoint pen black sharpie marker
 5. painters tape
 6. *Straight pins (flat flower heads if you have them, but not to worry if you don't, just bring what you have).
 7. *X acto knife, or paper scissors if you prefer
 8. Scotch magic tape
- *I will have these items * available for sale if you would like to purchase them.

Fabrics

Everyone bring:

1. 15 x 20" piece of background fabric on which to have as a foundation. It may be sky (sunset, sunrise), and/or water, any fabric foundation of interest on which to begin. (Hand dyes, or hand painted types work well for this). Since this is a one day class it will help to have this as part of the composition. You may want to bring 20" of tulle, light or dark, depending on day or night. (we use this for the water)
2. **fabrics:**
I find that batiks work very well for much of this project. Please select Batiks that are **multi-color and multi-value** in the same piece. You've seen those fabrics that range from very dark to very light in the same piece? Those "watercolor" splotchy, mottled type of multi value fabric (you know the ones, they look like someone used it to wipe up spills or clean their brushes. It's always best to bring a **variety** from which to choose. So bring lots of **fabric if you can**, bring a GOOD variety of values. **solids, florals or calicos don't work well.**
