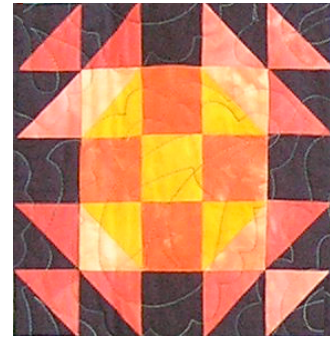

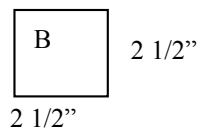
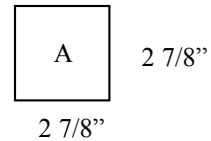
Block of the Month #6

Finished Size: 10"

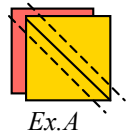


Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
Red	6 X 9"	6(A)
Orange	6 X 6"	4(B)
Dark Yellow	3 X 9"	2(A) 1(B)
Light Orange	3 X 6"	2(A)
Navy	12 X 12"	6(A) 4(B)

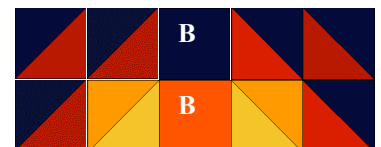


Sewing Directions

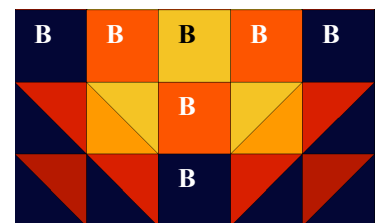
1. Make half square triangles by pairing two light orange (A) squares with two dark yellow (A) squares. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. (*Ex. A*). Cut on the drawn line and press toward the dark yellow fabric. This should result in a total of four half square triangles. Repeat this process with the red and navy (A) squares to create a total of 12 half square triangles. Press seams toward navy.



2. Using the navy and orange (A) squares, and the half square triangles unites created in step one, lay out the block according to block assembly diagram.



3. Sew the squares together in rows, then sew together the rows.
