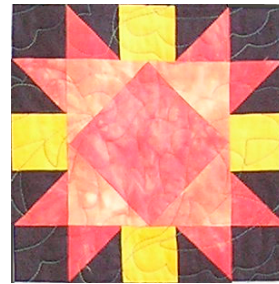

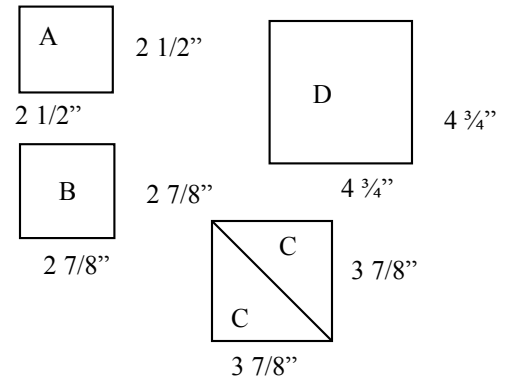
Block of the Month #7

Finished Size: 10"

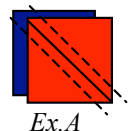


Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
Red	6 X 11"	4(B) 1(D)
Red Orange	4 X 8"	4(C)
Yellow	6 X 6"	4(A)
Navy	6 X 12"	4(A) 4(B)

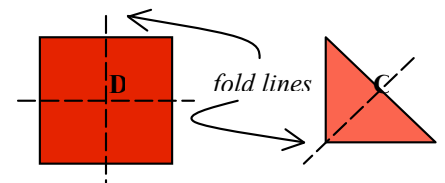


Sewing Directions

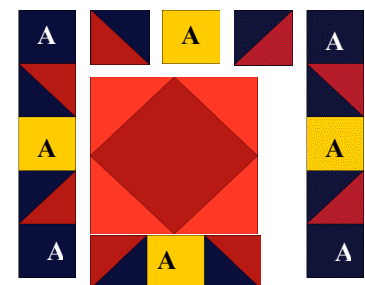
1. Make half square triangles by pairing the four red (B) squares with the four navy (B) squares. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. (*Ex. A*). Cut on the drawn line and press toward the navy fabric. This should result in a total of eight half square triangles.



2. To create the square in a square unit, first create registration marks by folding the red (D) square in half both horizontally and vertically. Create registration marks on the red orange (C) triangles by folding them in half. Sew a (C) triangle onto the (D) square matching registration lines. Press seam toward the red orange (C) triangle. The next red orange (C) triangle should be sewn to the opposite side of the (D) square. Sew on the remaining two (C) triangles, pressing all seams toward the red orange (C) triangles.



3. Using the navy and yellow (A) squares, the half square triangles units created in step one, and the square in a square unit from step two, lay out the block according to block assembly diagram.
