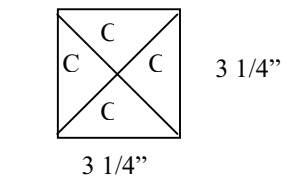
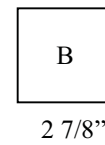
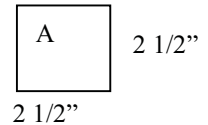

Blazar

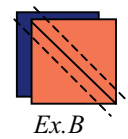

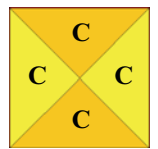
Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
Red	5 X 13"	2--1 1/2" X 5 1/2" strips 2 (B)
Red Orange	8 X 10"	6 (B)
Yellow Orange	8 X 12"	2 (A) 4 (C)* 1 1/2" X 5 1/2" strip
Yellow	8 X 12"	2 (A) 4 (C)* 1 1/2" X 5 1/2" strip
Navy	8 X 12"	4 (A) 4 (B)

*You will only use 2 of the four (C) triangles

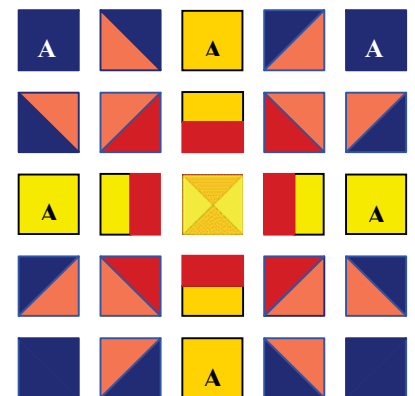
Sewing Directions

1. Sew a yellow orange 1 1/2" strip to One of the red 1 1/2" strips. Press toward the red. Cross cut into two 2 1/2" wide units as shown in Ex. A. Repeat with the yellow strip and the remaining red strip.

2. Make half square triangles by pairing four of the red orange (B) squares with the navy (B) squares. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. (Ex. B). Cut on the drawn line and press toward the navy fabric. This should result in a total of 8 half square triangles. Make the red/red orange half square triangles in the same manner using the remaining red orange (B) squares and the red (B) squares.

3. Sew together 2 of the yellow orange (C) triangles with 2 of the yellow (C) triangles according to Ex. C.

4. Lay out block pieces according to Block Assembly Diagram. Sew pieces into units, then the units into rows. Sew rows together. Press.
