Tools & Equipment

Add-a-Quarter™ Ruler	seam ripper or eyebrow tool
pencil	sewing machine
rotary cutter (45 mm)	needles, sharp 80
rotary mat	regular or walking foot
ruler (3x18 or 6x24)	iron & small ironing board
paper scissors	extension cord
fabric scissors	surge protector
thread, neutral color--tan or grey--40 or 50 weight	

Fabric

- Muslin, solid color, small scale prints, mellow batiks, or hand dyed fabrics work well for compass and ring backgrounds
- Backgrounds & Border--Choose one option
 - Option 1
 - All background and border one fabric--1 yard
 - Option 2
 - Compass and outer border background 2/3 yard
 - Flying Geese background 1/3 yard
 - Option 3
 - Compass background 1/3 yard
 - Flying Geese background 1/3 yard
 - Border background 2/3 yard
- Compass Points and Flying Geese--6 different fabrics, 1/8 yard each
 - *Option 3: One color for all flying geese 1/3 yard*
 - *Option 4: Random colors for geese--24 squares at 3 1/4"*
- Innermost Points (around center circle) 1/8 yard
