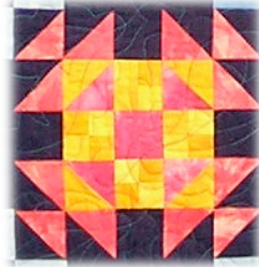

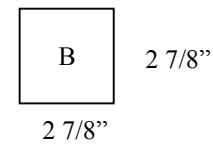
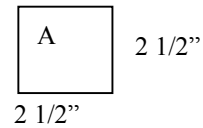
Block of the Month #12

Nubulae

Finished Size: 10"

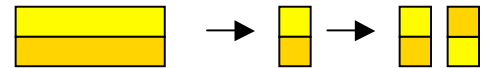


Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
Yellow	2 X 13"	1 1/2" strip
Yellow Orange	2 X 13"	1 1/2" strip 2 (B)
Red	9 X 3"	6 (B)
Pink	9 X 12"	1 (A) 2 (B)
Navy	12 X 12"	4 (A) 6 (B)



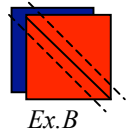
Sewing Directions

1. Sew a yellow 1 1/2" strip to a yellow orange 1 1/2" strip. Cross cut into eight 1 1/2" wide units. Sew together to make four 4-patch blocks as shown in *Ex. A*



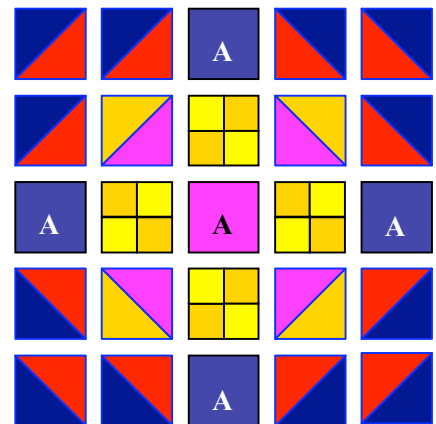

2. Make half square triangles by pairing the red (B) squares with the navy (B) squares. Draw a line diagonally from corner to corner. Sew 1/4" from both sides of the drawn line. (*Ex. B*). Cut on the drawn line and press toward the navy fabric. This should result in a total of 12 half square triangles. Make the pink/yellow orange half square triangles in the same manner using the pink and yellow orange (B) squares.

3. Using the navy and pink (A) squares, assemble block according to block assembly diagram.
